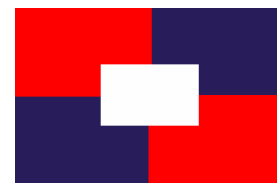

#### VENUE:

Beale Wildlife Park, Lower Basildon, Pangbourne, RG8 9NW.

1. All competitors will be Juniors (with the exception of Sch/J events). **Entries in the Sch/J events must be School pupils in the 2016/17 academic year.**
2. No competitor may race for more than one club on the day.
3. No composite entries will be admitted.
4. Clubs must be affiliated with British Rowing.
5. **All boats must have regulation boat identification codes.**

#### PRIZES:

Medals will be awarded to the winning crew in each event, provided at least 2 crews race. Silver and bronze medals will be awarded accordingly:  
Silver: 6 crews/singles racing  
Bronze: 6 singles/10 crews racing

#### ENTRIES:

**Entries only accepted through BROE.** The entry fee of £11 per seat must be paid by bank transfer or cheque to Entries secretary, (payable to Pangbourne College Ltd). Please email [annatowers@btinternet.com](mailto:annatowers@btinternet.com) to inform us of any transfer.

- No entry will be considered valid until payment has been received. The total number of crews will be limited. Acceptance will be in order of receipt.
- Entries must be made by 9pm on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2016. **We are often oversubscribed with entries closing up to 10 days before the closing date – please enter early.**
- For the purpose of creating a start order it is important that rowing coaches make clear the relative ability of the crews entered by identifying them as 'a', 'b', etc - with 'a' being the fastest crew in any status.
- An additional cheque must be sent to the **Entries Secretary** (payable to Pangbourne College Limited) to cover the deposit for empacher numbers; £10 per club with up to three boats entered, and £20 per club for those entering more than three boats. This will be refunded during the week following the event if numbers are returned. £5 per number will be deducted/charged for each unreturned/broken number.
- Please ensure that all previous boat numbers are removed, and that the numbers are clearly visible – ponytails not obscuring etc. Penalties may be given to crews with no visible race number.
